Dear Mr. Massie:

This letter is formal notice of the finding by the Illinois Department of Labor that the above named addressee's has violated the Illinois Prevailing Wage Act, 820 ILCS 130/1-12 (1994) for failure to pay the prevailing rate of wages for Cass County to its workers pursuant to Section 3 of the Act, concerning the above referenced matter. As the failure to pay the prevailing rate of wages occurred subsequent to January 1, 1990, and within a two (2) year period of the date of your FIRST VIOLATION (dated 09/20/2000 copy enclosed) please consider this a NOTICE OF SECOND VIOLATION as issued by the Illinois Department of Labor pursuant to 820 ILCS 130/11a; and the Prevailing Wage Hearing Procedures, 56 Ill. Adm. Code 100 et. seq. (copies enclosed).

Because the Illinois Department of Labor has determined that the above named addressee's has violated the provisions of the Illinois Prevailing Wage Act on two (2) separate occasions, the above named addressee's is bared from being awarded any contract to perform public works construction for a two (2) year period from the date of publication in the Illinois Register. The above named addressee's has ten (10) working days from the date of receipt of this NOTICE OF SECOND VIOLATION to request a hearing by the Illinois Department of Labor on the alleged violations. Failure to respond within that time period shall result in automatic and immediate debarment.
